

**Students who enroll in the
Department of Defense Dependents Schools
In The Republic Of Korea
Must meet the following immunization requirements:**

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| 1. Diphtheria, Pertussis, Tetanus
(DPT, DTaP, DT, DTP) | Four doses, the last one given after four years of age. A fifth dose is highly recommended. |
| 2. Oral/IM Polio
(OPV, IPV) | Three doses, the last one given after four years of age. A fourth is highly recommended. |
| 3. Measles, Mumps, Rubella
(MMR) | Two doses, the first one after one year of age and the second at least one month later, Preferably after four years of age. |
| 4. Hepatitis B
(Hep B, Recombivax, Energix) | A series of 3 immunizations. Series usually started at birth. |
| 5. Chickenpox
(Varicella, Varivax) | If your child has not had the disease they must be vaccinated against Chickenpox. |
| 6. Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis
(Tdap) | If your child is eleven years old or older, he/she needs the Tdap booster. |
| 7. IPPD (TB) Skin Test | Yearly |
| 8. Hepatitis A (HepA) | Two doses given 6 months apart. Series may be Started at any time. |
| 9. Meningococcal (MCV4) | Recommended between ages 11-12. |
